

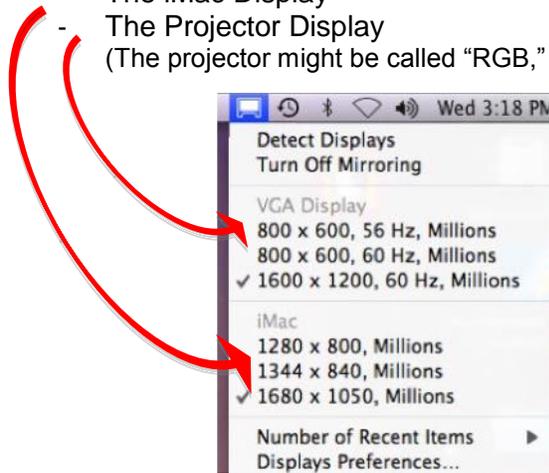
ADJUSTING YOUR COMPUTER DISPLAY TO WORK WITH YOUR PROJECTOR

In the upper right side of your computer screen, look for the monitor icon.

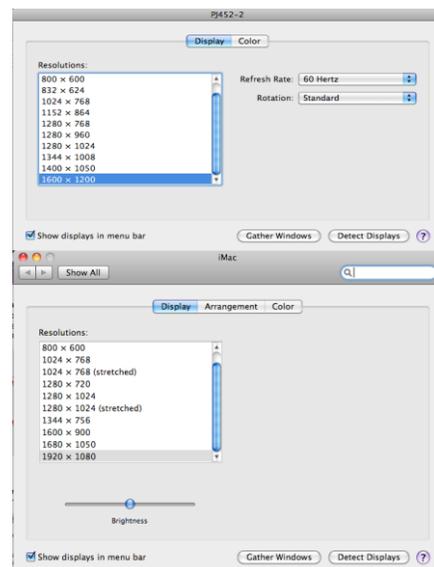
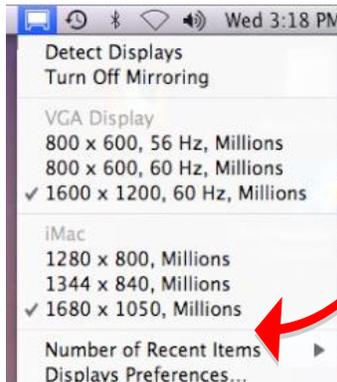


There are two displays to adjust. They may or may not be in this order:

- The iMac Display
- The Projector Display
(The projector might be called "RGB," "VGA," "PJ452," or something similar)



If the size you need isn't listed, you can find all of the possible sizes for your displays by opening "Display Preferences."



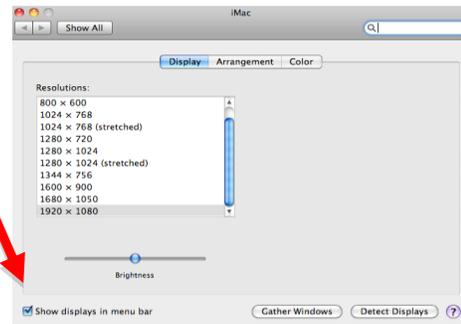
You will need to play with these settings until you find the ones that work best for you and the programs you are using. Often, changing the projector settings will cause the computer display to change; just change the computer settings again, until both displays appear the way you want them.

If your monitor icon is not already in the menu bar (at the upper, right side of your screen):

- Open "System Preferences" and choose "Displays."



- Check the box, "Show displays in menu bar."



What will you display?

You may choose to show the same image on both displays by choosing "mirror."

OR

You may extend your computer display onto both screens, with half shown on each by unchecking the "mirror" checkbox.
